Online Study Courses for employment in Catholic Schools 2021/2022

The Catholic Institute of Western Australia (CIWA) is offering online courses of study to pre-service teachers interested in completing the tertiary study component of Accreditation to Teach in Catholic schools or Accreditation to teach Religious Education to be employed in a Catholic school.

*However, unlike other offerings by CIWA at WA universities, these courses are **NOT** credited towards advanced standing in Teacher Education programs at universities.*

The three courses are taught over eight weeks in an **online only mode of study**. Each course has assessments that consist of two minor tasks and two learning journals that amount to 4000 words..

The first course is over the summer beginning in late November 2021 and finishing at the end of January 2022. The other courses are offered in School Term 2 and 3 respectively.

Summer 2021/2022

CIWA4040 Jesus

This course explores the nature of the person of Jesus and his core gospel teachings as understood within the Catholic Church tradition. Participants are to understand Jesus' mission to proclaim the 'good news' of the kingdom of God and how this news is applied through the Perth Archdiocesan Religious Education Units of Work to the life experience of students within Catholic school settings. The course provides opportunities for participants to reflect critically on the personal and professional readiness of staff to be supportive of or teach Jesus' gospel message in Catholic schools.

Tuition Fee:

\$550.00+gst for the 8 week online course

Tuition Duration:

Monday November 29 - Friday December 17, 2021 then Monday January 3 - Friday January 21, 2022.

Online only Study Mode:

Online learning through the Canvas Learning Management System Website with lectures, materials, tasks and assessments provided.

Term 2 2022

CIWA4050 Sacraments

This course explores the signs, symbols and rituals of key sacred liturgies within the Catholic tradition and their scriptural and historical origins. Participants are to understand the significance of the sacraments and liturgies to Christian life, especially the celebration of the Mass and how this is applied through the Perth Archdiocesan Religious Education Units of Work to the life experience of students within Catholic school settings. The course provides opportunities for participants to reflect critically on the personal and professional readiness of staff to be supportive of or teach sacraments and liturgies in Catholic schools.

Tuition Fee:

\$550.00+gst for the two modules over the 8 week course

Tuition Duration:

Monday May 2, 2022 – Friday 27 May, 2022 then Monday June 6, 2022 - Friday July 1, 2022

Online only Study Mode:

Online learning through the Canvas Learning Management System Website with lectures, materials, tasks and assessments provided.

Enrolment deadline: **Wednesday April 27, 2022**

Term 3 2022

CIWA4060 Gospels

This course explores the key structures and literary genres of the four Gospels as understood within the Catholic Church tradition. Participants are to understand how the Gospel writers wanted to convey Jesus' message of the Christian 'Way, Truth and Life' and how this message is applied through the Perth Archdiocesan Religious Education Units of Work to the life experience of students within Catholic school settings. The course provides opportunities for participants to reflect critically on the personal and professional readiness of staff to be supportive of or about how to promote Gospel values in Catholic schools.

Tuition Fee:

\$550.00+gst for the two modules over the 8 week course

Tuition Duration:

Monday July 25, 2022 – Friday August 19, 2022 then Monday August 29, 2022 - Friday September 23, 2022

Online only Study Mode:

Online learning through the Canvas Learning Management System Website with lectures, materials, tasks and assessments provided.

Enrolment deadline: **Wednesday July 20, 2022**
