Online Study Courses for Accreditation 2021/2022

The Catholic Institute of Western Australia (CIWA) offers online courses of study to teachers and leaders interested in completing the tertiary study component of Accreditation to teach, to teach Religious Education and/or for leadership in Catholic schools. The courses are taught over eight weeks during summer or a school term. Each course has online assessments that consist of two minor tasks and two learning journals.

Teachers completing these courses at the Bachelor's level (CIWA4000 code) will need to complete all assessments that amount to 4000 words. If teachers and leaders are seeking to use the courses towards Masters level equivalent units (CIWA6000 code), they will need to complete all assessments that amount to 6000 words.

Participants may wish to enquire with Catholic Education WA about using CECWA Scholarships for these courses. Up to two courses can count towards academic credit in the Bachelor of Education (Conversion) program and the Master of Education programs with specialisations in Religious Education or Leadership and Management (elective course only) at The University of Notre Dame Australia.

Summer 2021/2022

CIWA4040/6040 Jesus

This course examines the nature of the person of Jesus and his core gospel teachings as understood within the Catholic Church tradition. Participants are to analyse Jesus' mission to proclaim the 'good news' of the kingdom of God and how this news is applied through the Perth Archdiocesan Religious Education Units of Work to the life experience of students within Catholic school settings. The course provides opportunities for participants to reflect critically on the personal and professional readiness of staff to be supportive of or teach Jesus' gospel message in Catholic schools.

Tuition Fee:

\$550.00+gst for the two modules over the 8 week course

Tuition Duration:

Monday November 29 - Friday December 17, 2021 then Monday January 3 - Friday January 21, 2022.

Term 1 2022

CIWA4070/6070 Catholic Moral Teaching (NOT for Accreditation to teach Religious Education)

This course examines the principles of Catholic Moral Teaching as the basis for the Christian response to living a 'life in Christ' as a missionary disciple of the Catholic Church. Participants are to analyse how Christian principles of freedom and human dignity lie at the core of both scripture and Catholic tradition and how these are applied through the principles of Catholic Moral Teaching towards implementation in a contemporary Catholic school setting. The course provides opportunities for participants to reflect critically on the personal and professional readiness of staff to support or implement the principles of Catholic Moral Teachings in Catholic schools.*

\$550.00+gst for the two modules over the 8 week course

Monday February 7, 2022 – Friday March 4, 2022 then Monday March 14, 2022 - Friday April 8, 2022

Term 2 2022

CIWA4050/6050 Sacraments

This course examines the signs, symbols and rituals of key sacred liturgies within the Catholic tradition and their scriptural and historical origins. Participants are to analyse the significance of the sacraments and liturgies to Christian life, especially the celebration of the Mass and how this is applied through the Perth Archdiocesan Religious Education Units of Work to the life experience of students within Catholic school settings. The course provides opportunities for participants to reflect critically on the personal and professional readiness of staff to be supportive of or teach sacraments and liturgies in Catholic schools.*

Tuition Fee:

\$550.00+gst for the two modules over the 8 week course

Tuition Duration:

Monday May 2, 2022 – Friday 27 May, 2022 then Monday June 6, 2022 - Friday July 1, 2022

Online learning through the Canvas Learning Management System Website with lectures, materials, tasks and assessments provided.

Term 3 2022

CIWA4060/6060 Gospels

This course examines the key structures and literary genres of the four Gospels as understood within the Catholic Church tradition. Participants are to analyse how the Gospel writers wanted to convey Jesus' message of the Christian 'Way, Truth and Life' and how this message is applied through the Perth Archdiocesan Religious Education Units of Work to the life experience of students within Catholic school settings. The course provides opportunities for participants to reflect critically on the personal and professional readiness of staff to be supportive of or about how to promote Gospel values in Catholic schools.

Tuition Fee:

\$550.00+gst for the two modules over the 8 week course

Tuition Duration:

Monday July 25, 2022 – Friday August 19, 2022 then Monday August 29, 2022 - Friday September 23, 2022

Online only Study Mode:

Online learning through the Canvas Learning Management System Website with lectures, materials, tasks and assessments provided.

Enrolment deadline: Wednesday July 20, 2022
