CIWA Courses for Accreditation within Catholic Schools 2022/2023

The Catholic Institute of Western Australia (CIWA) is a unique Catholic tertiary educational body, created by and accountable to the Conference of Catholic Bishops of Western Australia. The Catholic Institute is offering courses of study to teacher education students interested in completing the tertiary study component of Accreditation to Teach Religious Education (ATRE) or Accreditation for Teachers, Psychologists and non-teaching staff in Leadership roles in Catholic schools (ATP+NTL) to be employed in a Catholic school.

Accreditation to Teach Religious Education (ATRE)

University students wishing to teach in a Catholic early childhood centre or primary school must be Catholic and be able to teach Religious Education. They should do ATRE. Students who are Catholic and wish to teach Religious Education in a Catholic secondary school should also do ATRE.

Accreditation for Teachers, Psychologists & non-teaching Leaders (ATP+NTL)

University students wishing to teach in a Catholic secondary school but not teach Religious Education or are specialist teachers in other Catholic school settings should do ATP+NTL.

*While these courses count towards accreditation with Catholic Education WA, they are **NOT** credited towards advanced standing in Teacher Education programs at universities.*

The courses are available to students via two modes of study. Students can choose to enrol into an **online only mode of study** delivered over eight weeks. Online study is delivered through the CANVAS Learning Management System with recorded lectures and discussion boards with materials, tasks and assessments provided. There are NO compulsory classes to attend.

Alternatively, they can enrol into a **blended mode of study** that allows for physical classroom attendance and online support. There are 'real life' class activities, lectures and discussions to participate in. The scheduled classes are held at the Newman Siena Centre, 33 Williamstown Road, Doubleview.

The blended mode of study requires a minimum of five participants, otherwise participants are invited to join the online group.

Each mode of study has assessments that consist of two minor and two major assessments that in total amount to 4000 words.

Summer 2022/2023

CIWA4040 Jesus

(Suitable for ATRE & ATP+NTL)

This course explores the nature of the person of Jesus and his core gospel teachings as understood within the Catholic Church tradition. Participants are to understand Jesus' mission to proclaim the 'good news' of the kingdom of God and how this news is applied through the Perth Archdiocesan Religious Education Units of Work to the life experience of students within Catholic school settings. The course provides opportunities for participants to reflect critically on the personal and professional readiness of staff to be supportive of or teach Jesus' gospel message in Catholic schools.

Online Mode of Study

Monday November 28, 2022 - Friday December 16, 2022 then Tuesday January 3, 2023 - Friday January 20, 2023.

Online study is delivered through the CANVAS Learning Management System with recorded lectures and discussion boards with materials, tasks and assessments provided.

Blended Mode of Study

Term 1 2023

CIWA4070 Catholic Moral Teaching

(Suitable for ATP+NTL ONLY)

This course explores the principles of Catholic Moral Teaching as the basis for the Christian response to living a 'life in Christ' as a missionary disciple of the Catholic Church. Participants are to understand that Christian principles of freedom and human dignity lie at the core of both scripture and Catholic tradition and how these are applied through the principles of Catholic Moral Teaching towards implementation in a contemporary Catholic school setting. The course provides opportunities for participants to reflect critically on the personal and professional readiness of staff to support or implement the principles of Catholic Moral Teachings in Catholic schools.

Online Mode of Study

Monday February 6, 2023 – Friday March 3, 2023 then Monday March 13, 2023 - Thursday April 6, 2023

Online study is delivered through the CANVAS Learning Management System with recorded lectures and discussion boards with materials, tasks and assessments provided.

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Blended Mode of Study

Monday February 6, 2023 – Thursday April 6, 2023 with classroom attendance on Saturday February 11, Saturday February 25, Saturday March 18 and Saturday April 1.

Blended study is delivered via physically present lectures and workshops complemented with materials, tasks and assessments provided on the CANVAS Learning Management System.

Term 2 2023

CIWA4050 Sacraments

(Suitable for ATRE and ATP+NTL)

This course explores the signs, symbols and rituals of key sacred liturgies within the Catholic tradition and their scriptural and historical origins. Participants are to understand the significance of the sacraments and liturgies to Christian life, especially the celebration of the Mass and how this is applied through the Perth Archdiocesan Religious Education Units of Work to the life experience of students within Catholic school settings. The course provides opportunities for participants to reflect critically on the personal and professional readiness of staff to be supportive of or teach sacraments and liturgies in Catholic schools.

Online Mode of Study

Monday May 1, 2023 – Friday 26 May, 2023 then Monday June 5, 2023- Friday June 30, 2023

Online study is delivered through the CANVAS Learning Management System with recorded lectures and discussion boards with materials, tasks and assessments provided.

Blended Mode of Study

Monday May 1, 2023 - Friday June 30, 2023 with classroom attendance on Saturday May 6, Saturday May 20, Saturday June 10 and Saturday June 24.

Blended study is delivered via physically present lectures and workshops complemented with materials, tasks and assessments provided on the CANVAS Learning Management System.

Term 3 2023

CIWA4060 Gospels

(Suitable for ATRE and ATP+NTL)

This course explores the key structures and literary genres of the four Gospels as understood within the Catholic Church tradition. Participants are to understand how the Gospel writers wanted to convey Jesus' message of the Christian 'Way, Truth and Life' and how this message is applied through the Perth Archdiocesan Religious Education Units of Work to the life experience of students within Catholic school settings. The course provides opportunities for participants to reflect critically on the personal and professional readiness of staff to be supportive of or about how to promote Gospel values in Catholic schools.

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Online Mode of Study

Monday July 24, 2023 – Friday August 18, 2023 then Monday August 28, 2023 - Friday September 22, 2023

Online study is delivered through the CANVAS Learning Management System with recorded lectures and discussion boards with materials, tasks and assessments provided.

Blended Mode of Study

Monday July 24, 2023 - Friday September 22, 2023 with classroom attendance on Saturday July 29, Saturday August 12, Saturday September 2 and Saturday September 16.

Blended study is delivered via physically present lectures and workshops complemented with materials, tasks and assessments provided on the CANVAS Learning Management System.

CIWA4080/6080 Catholic Social Teaching

(Suitable for ATP+NTL ONLY)

This course explores the principles of Catholic Social Teaching as the basis for the Christian response to justice and service in the mission of the Catholic Church. Participants are to understand that justice and service lie at the core of both scripture and Catholic tradition and how these are applied through the principles of Catholic Social Teaching towards implementation in a contemporary Catholic school setting. The course provides opportunities for participants to reflect critically on the personal and professional readiness of staff to support or implement justice and service activities steeped in Catholic Social Teaching in Catholic schools.

Online Mode of Study

Monday July 24, 2023 – Friday August 18, 2023 then Monday August 28, 2023 - Friday September 22, 2023.

Online study is delivered through the CANVAS Learning Management System with recorded lectures and discussion boards with materials, tasks and assessments provided.

Blended Mode of Study

Monday July 24, 2023 - Friday September 22, 2023 with classroom attendance on Saturday July 29, Saturday August 12, Saturday September 2 and Saturday September 16.

Blended study is delivered via physically present lectures and workshops complemented with materials, tasks and assessments provided on the CANVAS Learning Management System.
