



CIWA Courses for Accreditation within Catholic Schools 2022/2023

The Catholic Institute of Western Australia (CIWA) is a unique Catholic tertiary educational body, created by and accountable to the Conference of Catholic Bishops of Western Australia. The Catholic Institute provides blended and online courses for the tertiary study component of Accreditation for Teachers, Psychologists and non-teaching staff in Leadership roles, Accreditation for Middle Leaders, Accreditation to Teach Religious Education and Accreditation for Leadership in Catholic Schools as indicated below.

The Schedule indicates the courses available for the Accreditation categories. The CIWA4000 codes are for Catholic school staff who wish to study at the Bachelor's level. The CIWA6000 codes are for staff who wish to study at the Master's level. These courses can count towards tertiary credit with The University of Notre Dame Australia, Fremantle.

The *online mode of study* caters for independent, self-managing learning through online support. There are no classes to attend, lectures are recorded, study guidance provided and assessments and interactions are completed online. The *blended mode* caters for a 'conventional' classroom experience along with online support. There are 'real life' class activities, lectures and discussions to participate in. The blended mode of study requires a minimum of five participants, otherwise participants are invited to join the online group. There are four scheduled classes in each blended course complemented with resources and assessment tasks online between each class. The classes are held at Newman Siena Centre, 33 Williamstown Road, Doubleview on Saturdays 9.00am – 1.00pm.

All courses cost **\$650 (+\$65gst) per participant** paid via TryBooking. If payment is made via a school invoice, no GST is included. CECWA Scholarships can be used to cover the course cost.

Summer 2022/2023

CIWA4040/6040 Jesus

This course examines the nature of the person of Jesus and his core gospel teachings as understood within the Catholic Church tradition. Participants are to analyse Jesus' mission to proclaim the 'good news' of the kingdom of God and how this news is applied through the Perth Archdiocesan Religious Education Units of Work to the life experience of students within Catholic school settings. The course provides opportunities for participants to reflect critically on the personal and professional readiness of staff to be supportive of or teach Jesus' gospel message in Catholic schools.

Online Mode of Study

Monday November 28 - Friday December 16, 2022 then Tuesday January 3 - Friday January 20, 2023.

Online study is delivered through the CANVAS Learning Management System with recorded lectures and discussion boards with materials, tasks and assessments provided.

Tuition Fee: \$650.00 (+\$65gst) per participant paid via TryBooking. If payment is made via a school invoice, no GST is included. CECWA Scholarships can be used to cover the course cost.

Blended Mode of Study

Tuesday January 3, 2023 - Friday January 20, 2023 with classroom attendance on Wednesday January 4, Friday January 6, Monday January 9 and Wednesday January 11.

Blended study is delivered via physically present lectures and workshops complemented with materials, tasks and assessments provided on the CANVAS Learning Management System.

Tuition Fee: \$650.00 (+\$65gst) per participant paid via TryBooking. If payment is made via a school invoice, no GST is included. CECWA Scholarships can be used to cover the course cost.

Term 1 2023

CIWA4070/6070 Catholic Moral Teaching

(This course does NOT count towards Accreditation to Teach Religious Education)

This course examines the principles of Catholic Moral Teaching as the basis for the Christian response to living a 'life in Christ' as a missionary disciple of the Catholic Church. Participants are to analyse how Christian principles of freedom and human dignity lie at the core of both scripture and Catholic tradition and how these are applied through the principles of Catholic Moral Teaching towards implementation in a contemporary Catholic school setting. The course provides opportunities for participants to reflect critically on the personal and professional readiness of staff to support or implement the principles of Catholic Moral Teachings in Catholic schools.

Online Mode of Study

Monday February 6, 2023 – Friday March 3, 2023 then Monday March 13, 2023 - Thursday April 6, 2023

Online study is delivered through the CANVAS Learning Management System with recorded lectures and discussion boards with materials, tasks and assessments provided.

Blended Mode of Study

Monday February 6, 2023 – Thursday April 6, 2023 with classroom attendance on Saturday February 11, Saturday February 25, Saturday March 18 and Saturday April 1.

Blended study is delivered via physically present lectures and workshops complemented with materials, tasks and assessments provided on the CANVAS Learning Management System.

Tuition Fee: \$650.00 (+\$65gst) per participant paid via TryBooking. If payment is made via a school invoice, no GST is included. CEWA Scholarships can be used to cover the course cost.

Term 2 2023

CIWA4050/6050 Sacraments

This course examines the signs, symbols and rituals of key sacred liturgies within the Catholic tradition and their scriptural and historical origins. Participants are to analyse the significance of the sacraments and liturgies to Christian life, especially the celebration of the Mass and how this is applied through the Perth Archdiocesan Religious Education Units of Work to the life experience of students within Catholic school settings. The course provides opportunities for participants to reflect critically on the personal and professional readiness of staff to be supportive of or teach sacraments and liturgies in Catholic schools.

Online Mode of Study

Monday May 1, 2023 – Friday 26 May, 2023 then Monday June 5, 2023 - Friday June 30, 2023

Online study is delivered through the CANVAS Learning Management System with recorded lectures and discussion boards with materials, tasks and assessments provided.

Blended Mode of Study

Monday May 1, 2023 - Friday June 30, 2023 with classroom attendance on Saturday May 6, Saturday May 20, Saturday June 10 and Saturday June 24.

Blended study is delivered via physically present lectures and workshops complemented with materials, tasks and assessments provided on the CANVAS Learning Management System.

Tuition Fee: \$650.00 (+\$65gst) per participant paid via TryBooking. If payment is made via a school invoice, no GST is included. CEWA Scholarships can be used to cover the course cost.

CIWA4090/6090 Leading Catholic Schools

(This course does NOT count towards Accreditation to Teach Religious Education)

This course examines the goals and leadership of Catholic schools within the Church's mission of evangelisation. Participants are to analyse the vision of Catholic schools as Christ-centred and student-focused learning environments and how these are applied to the identity, culture and mission within contemporary Catholic school settings. The course provides opportunities for participants to reflect critically on the personal and professional readiness of staff to be supportive of or practise effective, faith-inspired Catholic leadership in Catholic schools.

Online Mode of Study

Monday May 1, 2023 – Friday 26 May, 2023 then Monday June 5, 2023 - Friday June 30, 2023

Online study is delivered through the CANVAS Learning Management System with recorded lectures and discussion boards with materials, tasks and assessments provided on the website.

Blended Mode of Study

Monday May 1, 2023 - Friday June 30, 2023 with classroom attendance on Saturday May 6, Saturday May 20, Saturday June 10 and Saturday June 24.

Blended study is delivered via physically present lectures and workshops complemented with materials, tasks and assessments provided on the CANVAS Learning Management System website.

Tuition Fee: \$650.00 (+\$65gst) per participant paid via TryBooking. If payment is made via a school invoice, no GST is included. CEWA Scholarships can be used to cover the course cost.

Term 3 2023

CIWA4060/6060 Gospels

This course examines the key structures and literary genres of the four Gospels as understood within the Catholic Church tradition. Participants are to analyse how the Gospel writers wanted to convey Jesus' message of the Christian 'Way, Truth and Life' and how this message is applied through the Perth Archdiocesan Religious Education Units of Work to the life experience of students within Catholic school settings. The course provides opportunities for participants to reflect critically on the personal and professional readiness of staff to be supportive of or about how to promote Gospel values in Catholic schools.

Online Mode of Study

Monday July 24, 2023 – Friday August 18, 2023 then Monday August 28, 2023 - Friday September 22, 2023

Online study is delivered through the CANVAS Learning Management System with recorded lectures and discussion boards with materials, tasks and assessments provided.

Blended Mode of Study

Monday July 24, 2023 - Friday September 22, 2023 with classroom attendance on Saturday July 29, Saturday August 12, Saturday September 2 and Saturday September 16.

Blended study is delivered via physically present lectures and workshops complemented with materials, tasks and assessments provided on the CANVAS Learning Management System.

Tuition Fee: \$650.00 (+\$65gst) per participant paid via TryBooking. If payment is made via a school invoice, no GST is included. CEWA Scholarships can be used to cover the course cost.

CIWA4080/6080 Catholic Social Teaching

(This course does NOT count towards Accreditation to Teach Religious Education)

This course examines the principles of Catholic Social Teaching as the basis for the Christian response to justice and service in the mission of the Catholic Church. Participants are to analyse how justice and service lie at the core of both scripture and Catholic tradition and how these are applied through the principles of Catholic Social Teaching towards implementation in a contemporary Catholic school setting. The course provides opportunities for participants to reflect critically on the personal and professional readiness of staff to support or implement justice and service activities steeped in Catholic Social Teaching in Catholic schools.

Online Mode of Study

Monday July 24, 2023 – Friday August 18, 2023 then Monday August 28, 2023 - Friday September 22, 2023

Online study is delivered through the CANVAS Learning Management System with recorded lectures and discussion boards with materials, tasks and assessments provided.

Blended Mode of Study

Monday July 24, 2023 - Friday September 22, 2023 with classroom attendance on Saturday July 29, Saturday August 12, Saturday September 2 and Saturday September 16.

Blended study is delivered via physically present lectures and workshops complemented with materials, tasks and assessments provided on the CANVAS Learning Management System.

Tuition Fee: \$650.00 (+\$65gst) per participant paid via TryBooking. If payment is made via a school invoice, no GST is included. CEWA Scholarships can be used to cover the course cost.
