As such, CST is an extension of Catholic Moral Teaching which is the basis for the Christian response to living a 'life in Christ' through missionary discipleship. Participants are to analyse how justice and service lie at the core of both scripture and Catholic tradition and how these are applied through the principles of Catholic Social Teaching towards implementation in a contemporary Catholic school setting.
